AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

Göteborg University, Sweden, and Klaipėda University, Lithuania, agree to contribute to the promotion of the unity of mankind by signing this agreement on cooperation based on the following conditions, principles and aims.

1.

We, the signing parties, promise to strive to develop bonds of mutual friendship between students, teachers and researchers of both universities.

2.

The parties agree that the cooperation should focus on the following subject areas:

- science
- mathematics including computing sciences
- social sciences including economics
- arts

For further definitions within each subject area see Appendix A.

3.

To promote cooperation the parties agree

- to exchange scientific publications and pedagogical documents in fields relevant to the cooperation
- to provide information on and promote participation of staff in congresses, conferences, scientific meetings and seminars arranged by either university
- to support exchange of staff, where teachers for a limited period of time partake in education or research according to agreements with departments or faculties at the other university
- to receive students from the other university, provided that they are eligible for studies at the host university

4.

The exchange programmes will be established on a department-to-department basis enabling professors, lecturers and researchers in the same field to propose arrangements of exchange of academic staff and students for scientific and educational purposes. Proposals of exchange should be approved by the heads of the university departments concerned.

5.

Exchanges or visits under this agreement will in principle be organized on a non-currency basis as reciprocal exchanges. Travelling expenses to the host country will be covered by the home university. All expenses within the host country will be covered by the host university, including accomodation, necessary travel within the host country and a per diem allowance.

The parties understand that financial agreements will have to be negotiated for each specific exchange project, and will depend on the availability of funds. Specific details for the implementation of academic activities will be developed mutually for specific projects.

6.

This agreement is valid from the date of signing and is automatically extended for one year at a time, unless cancelled by either party at least six months prior to its expiration.

7.

Any alterations of this agreement, agreed upon jointly by the two parties, will be submitted to the same proceedings as the original agreement and expressed in writing.

8.

This agreement of cooperation is made in two equally authentic copies in English, one of which to be deposited with each university.
