



**AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION**  
**between**  
**NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF RWANDA, Rwanda**  
**and**  
**UNIVERSITY OF GOTHENBURG, Sweden**

- §1           The purpose of this Agreement of Cooperation is to promote cooperation between the National University of Rwanda, hereinafter referred to as NUR, and University of Gothenburg, Sweden hereinafter referred to as GU.
- §2           This memorandum sets out the general nature of cooperation between the two parties.
- §3           By signing this Agreement the two institutions indicate their willingness to encourage cooperation and direct contact between schools/faculties and departments through planning, development and delivery of education and research in appropriate areas of expertise. In addition they agree to support other developments through the exchange of information and services where appropriate, or other activities as mutually agreed.
- §4           Each area of collaboration established within the framework of this agreement will be the subject of a separate annex to this memorandum. Such agreement will be signed by appropriate officers of the units and will specify details of the cooperation.
- §5           Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated and agreed upon with due regard to the availability of funds and other resources. Specific details for the implementation of activities will be developed mutually for each particular project.
- §6           Both universities subscribe to the policy of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, religion, national origin or disability.

- §7 Any dispute or disagreement which cannot be resolved through the procedures set out in the relevant annex to this memorandum shall be referred to a group composed of the Chair of the governing body of each party and one other member of the governing body from each institution chosen by the Chair. If the discussions are unsuccessful in resolving the matter the issue will be referred to independent mediator agreed by both Chairs. In the event that the matter cannot be resolved by negotiation or mediation as set out above, the parties agree to resolve the matter by arbitration, by which arbitration they will be bound.
- §8 This agreement is valid from the date of its signing by both parties and is automatically extended for one year at a time, unless cancelled by either party in writing at least six months prior to its expiration. It may be revised or modified at any time by mutual consent.
- §9 Any activities that have commenced at the date of termination may be concluded if both parties so agree.
- §10 This Agreement of Cooperation is made in two equally authentic copies in English, one for each of the signing parties.


