



## THE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GOTHENBURG

### Adlerbertska scholarships for the academic year 2018/19

The following scholarships from the Adlerbertska Scholarship Foundation, the Adlerbertska Student Housing Foundation, the Adlerbertska Grant Foundation and the Adlerbertska Pupil Housing Foundation are announced as available for the academic year 2018/19. First/second-cycle students or third-cycle students at the University of Gothenburg can apply for the scholarships. First/second-cycle students are qualified to apply if at the time of application they have pursued studies (full or half-time) for at least two semesters and have acquired at least 30 higher education credits at the University of Gothenburg. Third-cycle students are qualified to apply if at the time of application they are registered as a third-cycle student at the University of Gothenburg.

Individual students can receive a maximum of two scholarships during first-, and second-cycle of education and one scholarship during the third level; thus a maximum of three Adlerbertska scholarships. The scholarship amount for first/second-cycle students is currently SEK 15,000, and SEK 20,000 for third-cycle students.

Travel is prioritised when allocating Adlerbertska scholarships. It is possible to apply for two different trips on one application provided the cost of the first trip is less than the scholarship amount in question. There are also a small number of scholarships from the housing foundations that are allocated as grants for housing costs during the period of study. Only first/second-cycle students can apply for housing cost scholarships. Applications for travel- and housing costs scholarship is made in the same application form.

Applications for Adlerbertska scholarships are made via the University's web-based scholarship application system. After submitting an application digitally and receiving a '**Submitted**' status in the system, the application should be printed out and signed by the applicant. Applications for third-cycle students must also be signed by a supervisor/head of department. Only one application per person will be processed; if several applications are submitted, the last application submitted will be considered.

Paper applications must have been received by the University of Gothenburg no later than five working days following the application deadline.
