Call for proposals Centre for Business in Society

The Centre for Business in Society (CBiS) is a research centre at the School of Business, Economics and Law. The purpose of CBiS is to *promote and support research regarding how firms integrate sustainability into their business strategies and operative practices.*

The purpose of the call

To promote and support *international publications in academic journals and/or research grant applications*, CBiS here presents an open call for proposals.

We invite proposals that detail how support from CBiS can help the applicants achieve international publications and/or successful grant applications. The main applicant should be based at School of Business, Economics and Law, University of Gothenburg.

You can apply for salary costs and/or other costs (such as travel, transcription of interviews and conferences). Salary should include social fees (LOP). Any potential overhead costs associated with awarded project should be covered by the applicants' department, and the application form should therefore be signed by the head of the applicants' department.

There is no upper or lower limit for the applications, but keep in mind that CBiS has in total 150,000-200,000 SEK for this call.

Applicants receiving funding from CBiS should provide a short final report of how the funds have been used and the results at latest 1 July 2016.

The application process

Applications should include:

1. Application form
2. Project information
3. CV main applicant
4. Publications main applicant
5. Publications potential co-applicants

The evaluation process

The applications will be evaluated by internally at CBiS with support from CBiS' advisory boards. Only complete applications will be considered. Applicants will receive a decision via email at latest **31 October 2015**.
