ABOUT THE DOUBLE DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP

The School of Business, Economics and Law at the University of Gothenburg has established a scholarship for students who are accepted to the Double Degree exchange within the School's Master' education. The scholarship is funded by the Fredrik d'Orchimont Foundation and should be used for expenses during the year that the student spends at the partner university.

The amount differs from year to year, depending on the number of applicants, and is determined by the School in conjunction with the allocation of Double Degree places.

The following guidelines apply:

- You are eligible to apply if you have been selected for a Double Degree spot by the School of Business, Economics and Law at the University of Gothenburg.
- The scholarship amount is determined yearly, based on the number of applicants. The goal is to ensure that all of the School's Double Degree students obtain a scholarship.
- If you choose to interrupt your studies at the partner university, you are required to repay the scholarship to the foundation.

Applications are administered by the Faculty Office of the School of Business, Economics and Law. All students who have been selected for a Double Degree place will be contacted by the administrator and asked to fill out an application form.
