A commissioned course at the Institute of Neuroscience and Physiology at the Sahlgrenska Academy, University of Gothenburg.

TARGET AUDIENCE: Experienced clinicians working with specialized spinal cord injury rehabilitation

in the Nordic countries. To highlight focus on interprofessional teamwork we recommend that at least two individuals representing different professions, or preferably an interprofessional team (four to five), from each clinic/centre participate. Each participant should have at least 2 years' experience of working with Spinal Cord Injury (SCI) rehabilitation after relevant higher education of at

least 180 ECTS.

AIM: This course will add value for experienced professionals in SCI-rehabilitation

who want to develop their professional role and competencies further.

COURSE CONTENT:

• Anatomy and physiology related to limitations of function, activity and participation

- Medical and rehabilitative approaches in the acute and rehabilitative phase of traumatic and non-traumatic spinal cord injury
- Prevention, causes and treatment of complications in spinal cord injury
- Theoretical concepts for and application of interprofessional teamwork, team communication and leadership
- Improvement science
- Ethics
- Health promotion

COURSE FEE: SEK 12 000 excl. VAT per participant. The fee includes lunch and coffee during

start-up and finishing days in Gothenburg, access to lectures and seminars, a tutor and web-based learning resources. Travel and housing costs not included.
