

Call for Poster Proposals

With the purpose to share and make connections QRM encourage doctoral students and educational researcher to present their on-going research in the Posters session at the QRM conference.

These are the requirements:

- The poster should address some educational research question using quantitative research methods.
- Format of poster; No larger than width 78 x height 119 cm

The deadline for poster proposal is May 2.

Proposals should be sent via the form at https://qrm.se/conference/submission-poster and include an abstract of max 250 words, while further discussions can continue during the evening and the conference dinner.
