

## Scholarships in immunology

Students that are interested in participating in immunology based research projects are welcome to apply for a scholarship funded positions at the Tumor Immunology (TIMM) Lab at the Sahlgrenska Center for Cancer Research (SCCR), University of Gothenburg.

Our group consists of around eight people and our research focuses on tumor immunology and immunotherapy with a clear translational approach. Lately we have also performed studies on immune responses to SARS-Cov-2 infection and vaccination. Our studies utilize human patient samples, cell lines and mouse models. Methods commonly used in the lab include flow cytometry, PCR, Crispr/Cas9 gene editing, FACS-sorting, cell culturing, chemiluminescence and imaging. Please visit our homepage for more information:
