## Information

Admission to a later part of a programme is dependent on the availability of university resources to accept additional students within the programme. Admission to a later part can take place at the earliest on the second semester of the programme.

You have to have successfully completed courses that correspond with the previous semester(s)' studies. Furthermore, you need to meet the general and specific entry requirements for the programme in question.

If you have completed studies at a university other than the University of Gothenburg, you need to attach a study certificate to prove your previous studies - if the certificate is not submitted, the application is considered invalid and is not processed.

If not all applicants can be offered a place, you will be ranked based on the number of higher education credits. In the event of an equal number of higher education credits, the lottery decides.
