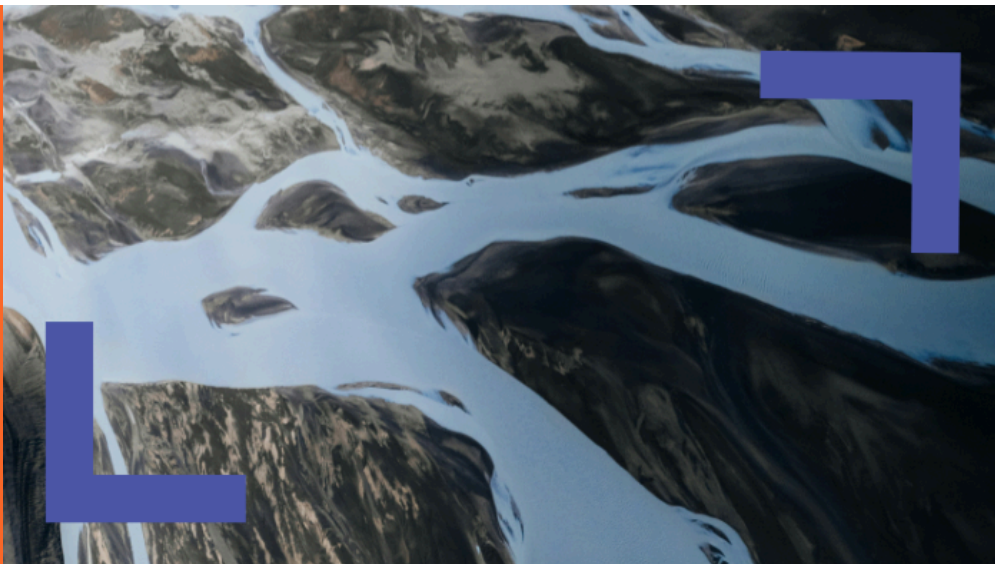

Unique international research review on hour-based violence

In international research there are several different explanations and understandings of honour-based violence, why it occurs and how these forms of violence manifest themselves. Researchers study different aspects of the problem, using different approaches and explanatory models. The first international research review of its kind presents a complex picture of the field.

Honour, violence and gender - an international research review is based on 30 years of research, a large number of articles and spans several different research disciplines. The combination of breadth and scope makes the research review unique. The publication is part of our focus area "An equal Nordic region".
