### Fact sheet regarding dataset on Gender and Diplomatic Representation, 1968 - 2024

*Version: June 2025*

#### Summary:

The GenDip dataset, covering the years 1968 to 2024 and 89,446 ambassador postings in total, reveals a steady and significant increase in the global representation of women in diplomacy. In 1968, women made up less than 1% of ambassadors<sup>1</sup> worldwide. Over the decades, this figure has grown consistently, reaching 23.4% in 2024. This upward trend reflects broader societal shifts toward gender equality and the increasing inclusion of women in high-level governmental roles.

Regionally, the Nordic countries have led the way, consistently maintaining the highest levels of female ambassadors with over 41% in 2024. Countries in Central and North America also showed strong increase, nearing 40%, followed by countries in Europe and Oceania. Africa and South America have seen moderate increases, while the increase in Asia and the Middle East is rather slow with female representation still below 15% in 2024.

When examining individual countries in 2024, some of the highest percentages of female ambassadors are found in countries with very small diplomatic representation. For instance, Sao Tome and Principe, Monaco, and Taiwan each report two-thirds of their ambassadors as women but these figures are based on less than ten ambassadors per country. This highlights the importance of considering the size of the diplomatic representation when interpreting such statistics.

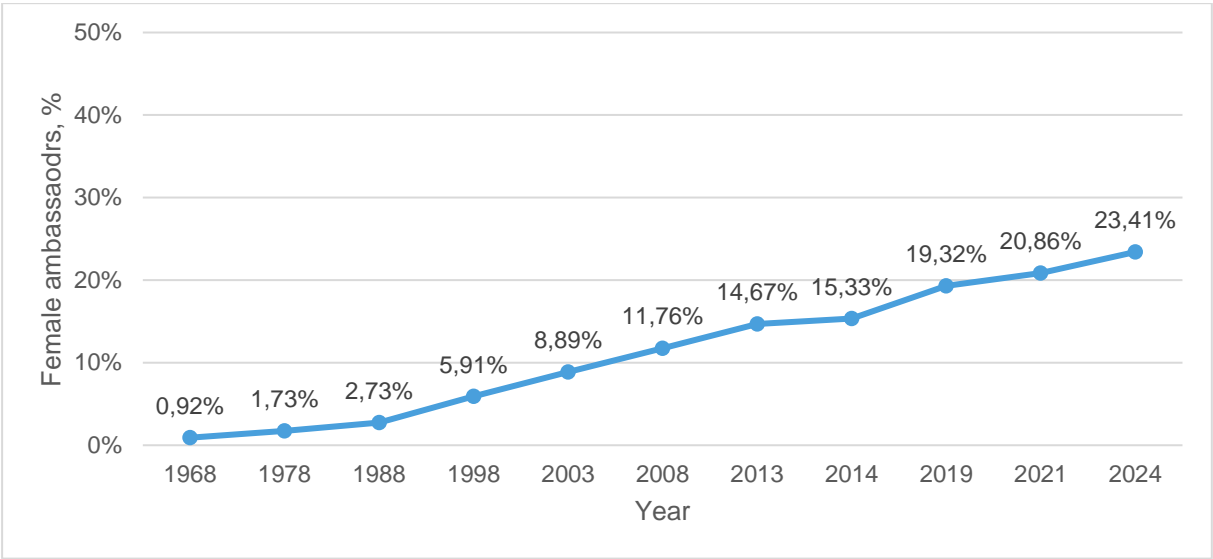
Focusing on countries with more than 50 ambassadors provides a more robust picture of gender representation on a scale. Among these, Finland, Canada, and the United States stand out, each with around or above 50% female ambassadors in 2024. Other notable countries include Sweden, South Africa, the Netherlands, Ghana, Norway, the United Kingdom, and Romania, all of which had over 40% female representation in 2024.

Overall, the GenDip dataset illustrates both change toward parity and persistent disparities. While global averages have increased, regional and national differences remain pronounced, underscoring the need for continued efforts to promote gender equality in international representation.

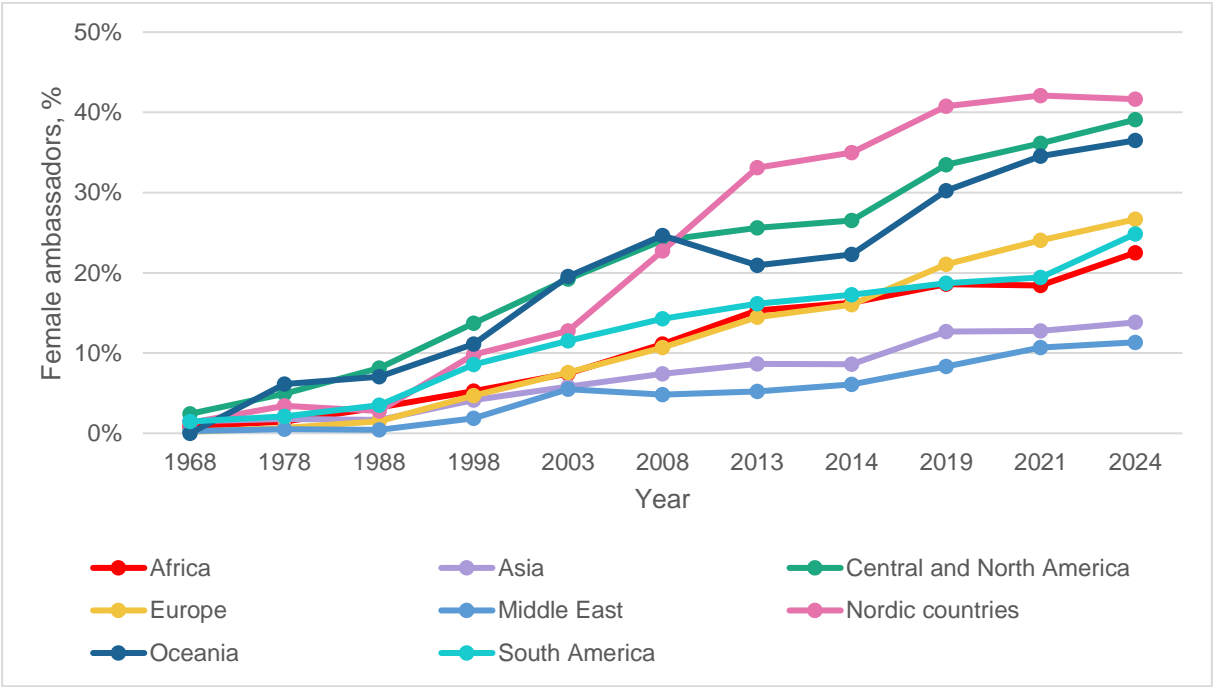
<sup>1</sup> We use the term ambassadors to signify heads of missions. The term ambassadors in this fact sheet also includes heads of missions with other titles such as high commissioners, chargé(e)s d'affaires, chargé(e)s d'affaires ad interim, acting ambassadors, ministers etc.

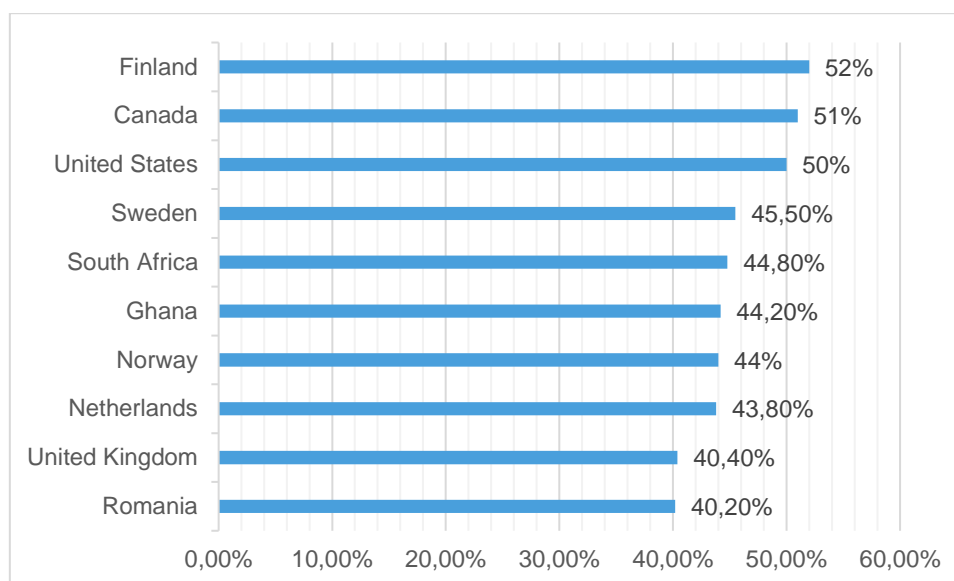
