Required knowledge for the different themes:

Marine Biology: At least 75 ECTS in Biology

Marine Chemistry: At least 45 ECTS in Chemistry

Marine Geology: At least 90 ECTS in Earth sciences/Geology

Physical Oceanography: At least 60 ECTS in the fields of Mathematics, Physics, Physical Oceanography, Meteorology or equivalent
