- Applicants must have completed 22,5 hp (credits) by the time of application

3 Eligibility to participate (before departure)

- Students must have successfully completed 60 ECTS prior to starting the study at University of Tor Vergata.

Choices and restrictions

Alternative at GU

GU-students going to TV must take **Advanced Microeconomic Theory II, Big Data Analytics for Business and Economics and Advanced Industrial Organization** at GU and cannot take these courses at TV.

Optional Courses at TV

Optional courses can be taken at any time, depending on availability.

Thesis

Each double degree student writes one thesis, but the same thesis is presented at both departments/universities. The thesis will be graded separately by two departments and may be awarded different grades.
