Call for Proposals

The school of Quantitative Research Methods in Education (QRM) invites doctoral students and educational researchers with an interest in quantitative research methods to our annual conference. This event is free of charge and is scheduled to take place on **June 15-16**. We invite proposals for individual papers and posters utilising quantitative research methods. Topics may span diverse educational research areas such as national or international large-scale assessments, social recruitment, segregation and inequalities within the educational system. We also welcome submissions that target methodological considerations and challenges in quantitative research.

Submission Guidelines

All proposals must include

- A title
- An abstract
- Up to five keywords

The abstract should include an introduction to the proposal, the main aim(s), methods, findings and key conclusion(s).

Poster

- Abstract: Maximum 250 words
- Poster size: Maximum 78 cm (width) × 119 cm (height)
- Submission deadline: April 12

Paper

- Abstract: Maximum 400 words
- Submission deadline: April 12
- Submit via [the paper submission form](#)
