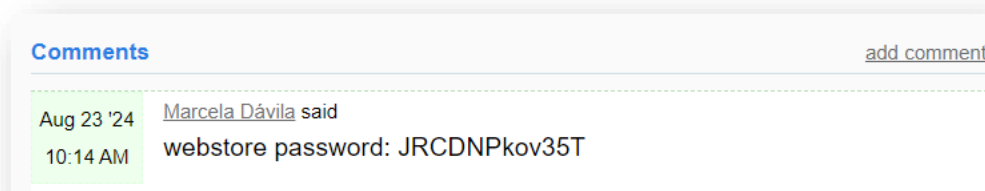
How to download data via sftp from our local server

Be sure to be connected through VPN to the University of Gothenburg. If you cannot, please contact cgg-it@gu.se.

You can access your data via **FileZilla** or connecting through **sftp**.
You will need the following:

Host: webstore.sa.gu.se
Username: your project ID from iLAB
Password: you find it in iLAB under comments (see example below)
Port: 22

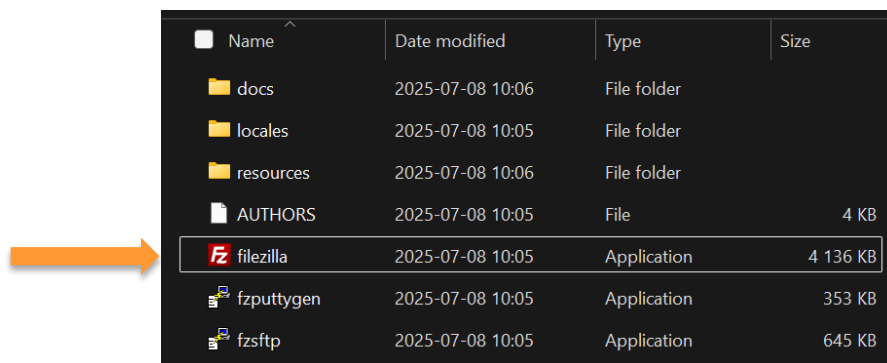

FileZilla:

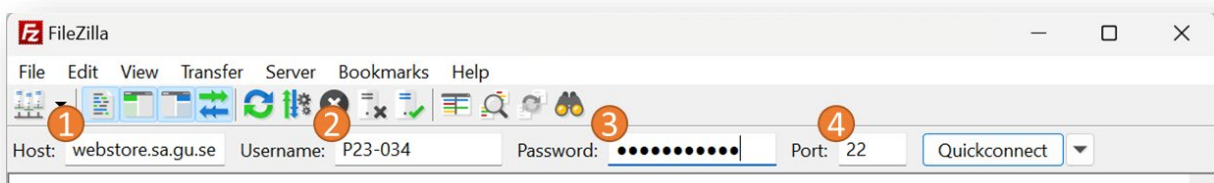
Download FileZilla Client from: https://filezilla-project.org/download.php?show_all=1

Windows: Download the zip version, unzip it and click on the FileZilla Application



! DO NOT download the **setup.exe** program

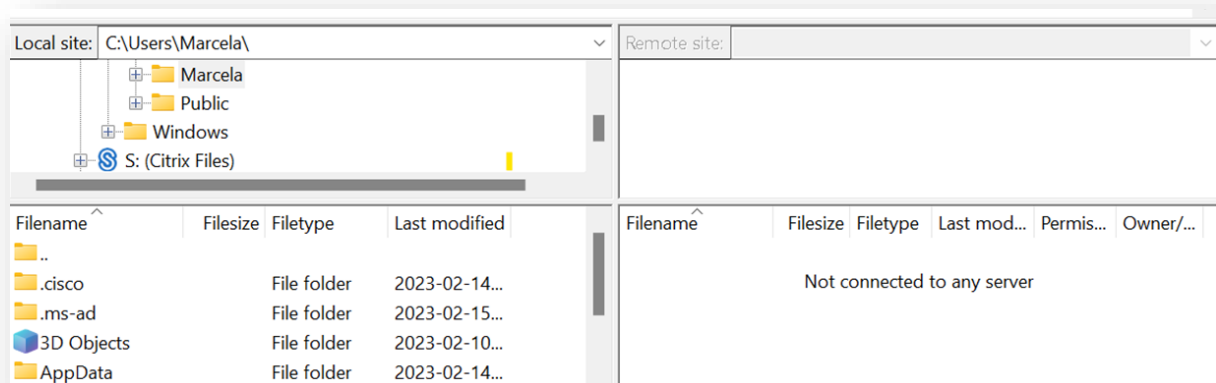
Fill in the Host (1), Username (2), Password (3) and Port (4)
Press “Quickconnect” (“Snabbanslut”):





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Enter the “data” folder on your right window and drag the data folder you want to download to the window on your left.

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sftp:

At your command line, connect to the server via sftp by typing (use your log in info):

```
sftp username@webstore.sa.gu.se
```

Enter the data/ folder by typing:

```
cd data/
```

List the content of the folder by typing:

```
ls
```

Download the data folder you want by typing:

```
get -R your_folder_name
```

Once you have downloaded your data, you can exit typing:

```
exit
```
