The Department of Clinical Neuroscience, Institute of Neuroscience and Physiology, hereby announces a vacant scholarship at undergraduate/advanced level in the subject:
Clinical carotid stenosis research

Training plan

Background: Carotid stenosis is a common cause of ischemic stroke. By prospectively gathering detailed clinical materials over long periods of time, research questions unsuited or impractical to answer in clinical trials can be answered. Collecting data in this manner requires in-depth understanding of the field and tried-and-tested logistical solutions. However, practical lessons learnt from such data gathering also have generic qualities, making practical experience in this field applicable to other fields.

Purpose: To gain experience in how to collect clinical data in the field of carotid stenosis.

Method: As part of the ongoing studies *Umeå Carotid Cohort (UCC)* and *Sahlgrenska Carotid Cohort (SCC)* the student will be trained in and conduct prospective data collection. This includes chart review, eCRF management, and via letter and telephone gather informed consent and follow-up data.

Time plan: 2026-10-01—2026-10-31

Learning outcome: To get practical experience in prospective clinical data gathering, making the student better prepared for similar own work in the future.
