These scholarships are for longer term stays at an international university or international field work, such as interviews with companies. The scholarships are in the range of 30000 SEK per student.

Students in the Master of Science programme Innovation and Industrial Management (IIM) and in Masters of Science programme Knowledge-based Entrepreneurship (KBE) at the School of Business, Economics and Law can apply for a scholarship to do their thesis work abroad. Note that students interested in doing thesis work in China should be connected with our partner university Zhejiang University, Hangzhou.

These scholarships arise thanks to a generous donation from the Sten A Olsson foundation for Research and Culture in the area of Innovation and Entrepreneurship.
