Our specialized unit treats patients with disorders of the thyroid, parathyroids, adrenals, gastroentero-pancreatic tumours, retroperitoneal sarcomas and abdominal sarcomas (i.e. gastrointestinal stromal tumours - GIST). Our group has had a long tradition of endocrine surgical research, with landmark publications on medullary and papillary thyroid carcinoma, now focusing on neuroendocrine tumours and GIST. Since 2005, Sahlgrenska University Hospital is a participating center in the Scandinavian Quality Registry for Thyroid and Parathyroid surgery incorporating Adrenals.
