Axel Wolf is the vice head for Innovation, Digitalisation and Utilisation at the Institute of Health and Care Sciences, Sahlgrenska Academy, University of Gothenburg, Sweden. He holds a combined position as Associate Professor and senior consultant nurse anaesthetist at the Sahlgrenska University Hospital and Sahlgrenska Academy at the University of Gothenburg. Axel has an executive MBA degree from the University of Gothenburg School of Business, Economics & Law and a PhD in healthcare science from the Sahlgrenska Academy at the University of Gothenburg.

He is affiliated to The Gothenburg University Centre for Person-centred Care (www.gpcc.gu.se), an interdisciplinary research centre with over 100 national and international researcher. During 2012-2014, he was also on the executive team for the centre, and the project lead for the design and development of customised change programmes for hospitals and healthcare organisations. His research taps on different aspects of Person-centred healthcare services: exploring the organisational prerequisites of implementing person-centred care, Patient- and Public Involvement (PPI), mobile eHealth & Peer-to-Peer platforms. He collaborates with researchers in the USA (Duke University), Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, UK (University of Exeter & University of Plymouth), Finland (University of Åbo), Denmark (University of Copenhagen), Austria (University of Graz). Currently, he is the chair for the European standardisation committee (CEN/TC450) on patient involvement in person-centred care.



Dr Wolf is the chair for the European standardisation committee (CEN/TC450) on patient involvement in healthcare services, with the aim to create favourable structural conditions for person-centred care on a European level.

Dr Wolf has raised over 1.7 million euros in research funding as primary investigator or co-investigator since 2010.

Together with collaboration partners from Sahlgrenska University Hospital, Region Västra Götaland, and Industry partners IBM, Astra Zeneca and Doberman, the consortium received initial funding of 3 million SEK during 2012-13 from Vinnova, the Swedish Governmental Agency for Innovation Systems. The project "National Reference Ward for Person-centred Care (NATREF PCV)" aimed to develop the person-centred health care ward of the future and be an open and sustainable testbed for new care forms, services and products such as education, eHealth and IT solutions. NATREF PCV constituted a reference point for the health care of the future, both nationally and internationally through identifying, developing and integrating partial solutions for a change in health care. Outcome: The national reference wards for PCC have reduced their length of hospital stay with 20% and increased patient satisfaction as well as staff engagement level.
